1. Introductions and Roll Call

- 2. Review and Approve Minutes from November 9, 2022, meeting Bradner moved to approve; seconded by Suda. Motion carried.
- 3. Updates from Consortium Director and Individual Schools Mitch Jorgensen, Fordville-Lankin, updated the group that they will be leaving the HOV-ITV Consortium. They are joining the Grafton consortium as it is closer and they are streamlining all their distance education. Thank you to the HOV-ITV Consortium for all we've done. Discussion followed regarding reorganization with CTE and technical education centers.

- 5. Course Needs/Issues (ITV and Dual Credit): Hatton needs Biology for sophomore science. Please contact Kevin Beaudoin if interested in sharing an instructor or sending science classes via ITV. Discussion was held on what districts are doing for cybersecurity needs and developing courses. The Fordville-Lankin technology teacher is getting a course ready for 2024-2025. A discussion followed on teacher needs and staffing needs.
- 6. By-laws—Best to wait on this and see where things go over the next year with the HOV-ITV Consortium.
- 7. 2023-2024 Calendar Approval—Suda motioned that schools follow the sending school calendars rather than having a standard calendar. Bradner seconded the motion. Motion carried. Hatton and Mayville State are starting August 22.
- 8. 2022-2023 budget summary and 2023/2024 budget discussion and approval-Wuori Reminder: if any instructors were sent out to school sites and have mileage to report, be sure to send that in to Misti in the next week to approve by June 30th

Wuori reviewed the financial statements shared prior to the meeting. For the HOV-ITV 2023-2024 Budget/Operations, Bradner questioned if the HOV management contract cost of \$14,083 was too high considering the decline in courses offered. How many hours go into that? Suda motioned to approve the budget as is with an adjustment to the Expenses that Misti will present and discussion will be had via email. Beaudoin seconded. Motion passed.

9. 2023-2024 HOV-ITV membership dues? The motion was made by Currie and seconded by Suda to waive HOV-ITV membership dues for 2023-2024. Motion carried.

Bradner motioned to have schools leaving the HOV-ITV Consortium or not using their HOV-provided systems to keep and store the ITV systems in their local district. Additionally, the exit fees will be waived for districts leaving the HOV-ITV Consortium. Districts leaving the consortium will assume the cost of repairs on their equipment and may be asked to return their HOV-ITV Polycom unit to the consortium if needed in another district. Suda seconded. Motion carried.
